WINEGROWING

Organic production (PT-BIO-08) with a single plot managemement winegrowing work.

WINEMAKING Individualized plot work from the harvest until the ageing in barrels. Handmade harvest, desteming with no crushing. Fermentation in stainless steel temperature controlled vats. Prolonged maceration. Average yield per plot: 3 ton/ha.

AGEING 16 to 18 months in french oak barrels, 40% of which new ones.

THEME "There's metaphoric gold in 'dem there hills" A wine grown on a privileged terroir. A terroir whose slopes are covered with unique golden colours at sunset time. A terroir that since the 17th century has been known as the Hill of Gold.
