WINEMAKING Alicante Bouschet from 2017 with fermentation in treading lagar, Trincadeira from 2018, 2019 and 2020 with fermentation in tanks.

AGEING The Alicante Bouschet aged in a 2200 litre foudre. At the end of each 12 month period, 10% of the volume is removed and Trincadeira is added. In total, it has aged for 4 years.

TASTING NOTES A very balanced wine, with a perfect harmony between the robustness of Alicante Bouschet and the elegance brought by Trincadeira. Surprising aromatic freshness and a perfect integration of the oak. The result is a polished red wine, with great finesse of dark fruit and a remarkably classy finish.
